Talk to your doctor: Your doctor can provide a valid prescription for FDA-approved medicines containing semaglutide and guide you on where to fill that prescription.



Use a reliable state-licensed retail pharmacy: Getting your medicines from a reputable and wellestablished pharmacy will help as retail pharmacies purchase FDA-approved medicines containing semaglutide through authorized distributors of Novo Nordisk.



Inspect the medication: The FDA recommends that you ask yourself, "Does the drug or packaging look different than what you normally receive?"1

What to do if you spot counterfeit "semaglutide":





Talk to your doctor: If you think you are taking a counterfeit product, you should immediately discontinue use and contact your healthcare provider.



Report side effects: You are encouraged to report the side effects to FDA's MedWatch Safety Information and Adverse Event Reporting Program (1-800-FDA-1088 or www.fda. gov/medwatch) as well as to Novo Nordisk Customer Care number (1-800-727-6500).
